

LBQ MEMBERS VITA

Klaus Ulrich Dann, trumpet

Is a member of the Stuttgart Bach Collegium and lectures at the Stuttgart College of Music. He studied at the “Stuttgart Musikhochschule” and has played professionally since then. As a soloist he is a specialist on the Baroque-Piccolo-Trumpet and a well known performer in South Germany. Amongst others, Klaus Ulrich Dann has recorded a CD of music for trumpet and organ and another with the ensemble “Süddeutsche Bläsersolisten”.

Hubertus v.Stackelberg, trumpet

Studied at the “Stuttgart Musikhochschule” and is a freelance musician appearing in all types of music productions as soloist or as an ensemble player. His repertoire ranges from early Baroque music to Bigband-Music. He has also played on many recordings of twentieth century music with the Ensemble Modern (Frankfurt) and others. He is the founder of the ensemble “con voce festiva” and, together with Klaus Dann and Matthias Jauß, of the “Ludwigsburg BrassQuintet.” Besides his performances on the trumpet, von Stackelberg is professor for aesthetics and culture at the Protestant University of Applied Sciences in Ludwigsburg, where he has worked since 1992.

Harald Domes, frenchhorn

Joined the LBQ as the horn player in 1993. After studying at the Würzburg College of Music, he was a member of the Munich Symphony Orchestra for a year, before moving to the Kaiserslautern Pfalztheater as a principal horn player. He is in demand as a guest in many orchestras and ensembles.

Matthias Jauß, trombone

Received his musical studies on the trombone at no less than three Colleges of Music: Stuttgart, Mannheim and Hamburg. After two years in the NDR Symphony Orchestra Hamburg, he moved to the Pfalztheater Kaiserslautern where he is the Principal Trombonist. He also plays in the Stuttgart Baroque Orchestra, the Bach Collegium Stuttgart and the Bach Orchestra Mainz.

David Polkinhorn, Tuba

studied at the Royal Academy of Music in London and the “Hochschule für Musik und Theater, Hannover”. During his studies he appeared with various Orchestras and Ensembles including the Ni Ensemble (First prize International Brass Ensembles competition Passau 2006) of which he is a founding member. David Polkinhorn has held the position of Principal Tuba in Radio Symphony Orchestra Saarbruecken since September 2003. As a freelance musician he has appeared with, among others, the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra, London Symphony Orchestra, Orchestra of the Bavarian State Opera and Stockholm Chamber Brass. David has been a regular member of LBQ since 2006 and has already recorded three CD’s with the group.
